

APPLICATIONS:	SPHK1 antibody can be used in immunohistochemistry starting at 40 ug/mL, and flow cytometry.
USER NOTE:	Optimal dilutions for each application to be determined by the researcher.
SPECIFICITY:	BLAST analysis of the peptide immunogen showed no homology with other human proteins.
IMMUNOGEN:	SPHK1 antibody was raised against a peptide located in the N-Terminal domain of SPHK1 (Human).

PURIFICATION:	Immunoaffinity Chromatography
PHYSICAL STATE:	Liquid
BUFFER:	PBS, 0.1% sodium azide.
STORAGE CONDITIONS:	SPHK1 antibody should be stored long term (months) at -80 °C and short term (days) at 4 °C. As with all antibodies avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
CLONALITY:	Polyclonal

Background

BACKGROUND: Sphingosine kinase (SPHK) phosphorylates sphingosine to form a bioactive lipid mediate, sphingosine 1-

phosphate (S1P or SPP). S1P is a novel lipid messenger with both intracellular and extracellular functions. Intracellularly, it regulates proliferation and survival while extracellularly it is a ligand for EDG 1. Expression of SPHK1 and subsequent production of S1P promotes the G1-S transition, protects cells from apoptosis, stimulates migration and angiogenesis, and induces tumor formation in mice.
